Itinerary:	In the morning, visit the Mogao Caves , the largest and richest ancient art treasure-trove in the world, once held over 1,000 caves with rock art dating back to the Northern Wei Dynasty (385 – 557) and Sui Dynasty (581 – 618). Most of the caves were made during the Tang Dynasty (until ca. 750), when Buddhism and the Silk Road were in their prime. It was inscribed as a World Heritage Site by UNESCO in 1987.	In the afternoon, visit the Mingsha Sand Dunes and Crescent Spring , a natural wonder in the Gobi Desert. You can take a camel ride, try sand surfing or sport utility vehicle at the Mingsha Sand Dunes (at own cost).	Visit the Great Wall of the Han Dynasty , built by alternative layers of sand and weed. Proceed to the Yumenguan Pass (Jade Gate Pass) , a strategic pass on the ancient Silk Road where caravans heading out of China would travel up the Hexi Corridor to Dunhuang. After lunch, Onwards to Dunhuang Yadan National Geopark (Ghost City) . "Yadan" refers to a precipitous hillock in Uygur language, a kind of wind-eroded landform. In geological terms, a "ghost city" refers to the wind-eroded landforms or Yadan landforms. (L)
