

***Kaiping Diaolou Cluster*** was inscribed as World Heritage Site by UNESCO in 2007. To safeguard property and lives, a different type of buildings were built in Kaiping. In the early 1920s, building Western-Chinese style houses and adapting some western style furniture were all the rage, presenting a complete picture of the success and aspirations of the returning Kaiping emigrants.



## 2 Days Kaiping Diaolou Cluster Tour

Departure: Every Sat

**Day 1**      **Tsim Sha Tsui**  **Jiangmen**      **Approx. 2.5 hours ferry**  
**Jiangmen**  **Kaiping**      **Approx. 1 hour coach**

Take a ferry from the China Hong Kong City Ferry Pier to Jiangmen. Upon arrival, transfer to Kaiping. Visit the ***Zili Village*** and ***Li Garden***. The various Diaolous in Zili Village are the representatives of Kaiping Diaolous during their booming time. The Li Garden was built by an overseas Chinese American Mr. Xie Wei Li around 1926 and finished in 1936. The garden blends harmoniously the elements of Chinese traditional gardening, Southern Chinese water-town style landscaping and Western architecture.

**Day 2**      **Kaiping**  **Jiangmen**      **Approx. 1 hours coach**  
**Jiangmen**  **Tsim Sha Tsui**      **Approx. 2.5 hours ferry**

Visit the ***Ancient Town Chikan***. The town has a history of over 350 years, and it is an ancient town of overseas Chinese hometown with the strong characteristics of the southern part of the country. The ***Guan and Situ Clan libraries*** become the landmarks of Chikan. Then visit the ***Majianglong Village***, built against the Baizu Mountain and faces the Tanjiang River in the south. These well preserved and elegantly designed Diaolous and villas have been well coexisting with the nearby houses and natural environment. Drive to Jiangmen for a ferry back to Tsim Sha Tsui, Kowloon.
