

Huangshan Trekking Tour is not only a good physical training, but it also offers an opportunity for you to enjoy the beautiful scenery of the landscapes and get into the local ancient villages in Huangshan up-close. Join us to climb atop the renowned Mt. Huangshan (Yellow Mountain) ranging from 770 m to 1,630 meters above sea level. It takes approximately 6 hours to finish this 14 km trek.



5 Days Huangshan Trekking Tour

Best travel months: Apr – Nov

- Day1** **Hong Kong → Hangzhou** **Approx 2.5 hours flight**
Huangshan 🚗 Tunxi **Approx 3.5 hours coach**
 Fly to Hangzhou and transfer to Tunxi. Onwards to the *Tunxi Ancient Street*, with centuries-old buildings dating back to the Song Dynasty (960 – 1279).
 Accommodation at Tunxi Lodge (Culture Hotel) or similar (L & D)
- Day 2** **Tunxi 🚗 Mt. Huangshan Scenic Area** **Approx 1.5 hours coach**
 After breakfast, transfer to *Ciguang Pavilion* – the starting point of **Huangshan Trekking Tour**. Then begin the 14 km trekking. Enjoy the majestic, steep and stunning scenery of Huangshan along the way. Passing by *Yupinglou*, there is the famous odd-shaped *Ying Ke Pines* and can overlook the *Celestial Capital Peak*. The finish line is at Beihai Hotel. Enjoy dinner at the hotel.
 Accommodation at Beihai Hotel (4-star) or similar (B, L & D)
- Day 3** **Huangshan 🚗 Yi County** **Approx 1.5 hours coach**
 Watch the sunrise at *Bei Hai Lion Peak*. Passing by the Huiyin Wall to *Paiyun Pavilion*, enjoy the stunning view of *West Sea*. Visit *Shixin Peak* and see the famous Huangshan pine trees. Take the cable car down the mountain (or about 2 hours on foot). Go to the Yi County.
 Accommodation at Xidi Travel Lodge (Culture Hotel) or similar (B, L & D)
- Day 4** **Yi County**
 Visit the *ancient villages of Xidi* and *Hongcun*, UNESCO World Heritage Sites, which offer the most representative local-style residences of southern Anhui Province. Built in the Northern Song Dynasty (960-1127), Xidi Village presents primitive simplicity and elegance of Hui Culture with exquisite three carvings architecture and cultural scenery. *Hongcun* is an ox-shaped ancient village in the peach blossom valley of the ancient Yi County, which was built in Southern Song Dynasty (1131-1162). Visit the *Nan Ping Village*, with around three hundred or more ancient residential houses.
 Accommodation at Xidi Travel Lodge (Culture Hotel) or similar (B, L & D)

Day 5

Tunxi 🚗 Hangzhou

Approx 3.5 hours coach

Hangzhou → Hong Kong

Approx 2.5 hours by flight

Visit **Tangyue Memorial Archway Group**, which consists of seven memorial archways built in the Ming and Qing dynasties (1368-1911) and is arranged in the order of loyalty, filial piety, moral integrity and justice. Visit the private garden of a Hui businessman - **Bao's Garden** which is a traditional garden in typical ancient Huizhou-style combining a potted landscape. Visit **Qingyi Ancestral Hall**. Traditional Ancestral Hall in China was male-dominated. Qingyi Ancestral Hall is a rare hall to be female-dominated. Transfer to Hangzhou after lunch and take a flight back to Hong Kong. (B & L)
